

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is The Global Leadership Summit?

What does the conference price include?

Who qualifies for the Student/Faculty/Military rate?

All high school, undergraduate, and graduate students (whether full or part-time students) are eligible for the Student rate. The Faculty rate applies to those individuals on staff at a college, university, or seminary. U.S. Military Active Duty and Reserve personnel and their spouses may register at the Military rate.

Do I need to have all the names of our group when I register?

Willow Creek Association allows groups to reserve "Empty Registrations" and then submit names of those who will be attending at a later date. We encourage you to enter those names by mid July; however, a registrant's name can still be added or changed before printing the final ticket.

Can I share a registration with someone if I can't attend the entire event?

Willow Creek Association does not provide the option to share registrations between two or more individuals. The event has been designed as a holistic learning experience and is best if attended in its entirety.

What is your cancellation/hold/transfer policy?

You must contact the Willow Creek Ministry Operations Team on or before 6/14/2016 for a refund of your conference fees less a \$45.00 cancellation fee per person.

HOLD POLICY:

Should you wish to hold your registration for future use, you must contact us on or before 7/12/2016. You will need to contact us within a year to utilize the fund toward a new conference registration. Your registration fees will be transferred to the conference selected less the \$45.00 transfer fee per person. Additional payment may be required depending on the price of the new conference. Any overpayment remaining after the transfer is non-refundable.

TRANSFER POLICY:
