Discussion Questions:

1. What is an embarrassing or “facepalm” moment you have had that was not funny to you at the time but you can laugh about now?
2. Pastor Sean shared an embarrassing story of how he tried to look like a “real” videographer and missed the mark. Where do you feel the most pressure to prove yourself? Is it at work, with family, socially, spiritually, or somewhere else? Where does this pressure come from?
3. Read Luke 2:6. When you picture the birth of Jesus, what stands out to you most about God choosing that entrance for His Son into the world?
4. How does knowing that Jesus lived with nothing to prove challenge the way we approach our own insecurities or image?
5. Read Philippians 2:6-8. Why is Jesus’ example of humility such a powerful display of love?
6. How might your relationships change if you approached them with the same “nothing to prove, everything to give” mindset?
7. Read John 3:16 aloud. God offered His Son, who gave His life, and we gain everything simply by believing in Jesus. What makes simple belief surprisingly difficult at times?
8. As you look ahead to this Christmas, what is one way you want to lean more fully into the humility and generosity of Jesus?
