## From Spark to Fire A Move of God - Part 2 September 21, 2025

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. If you could describe what you most hope to see God do in our church or Acadiana in one word or phrase, what would it be?
- 2. Pastor Sean used the metaphor of tending a new fire to illustrate revival. You can't just light it and leave it, or it will go out. How does that picture help you think about revival—both in protecting it and in fueling it?
- 3. Some indicators of revival were listed, throughout the country and right here at The Bayou. Which one stood out to you the most? Why?
- 4. Revivals can be derailed by politics, hate, division, and nationalism. Yet, 1 Corinthians 15:1-4 reminds us that revival is ultimately about the Gospel. How does keeping the Gospel central protect us from emotional highs or distractions?
- 5. Read Luke 6:27-36 aloud. How well did you do loving your enemies this week? If you're comfortable sharing with the group, who in your life is God prompting you to pray for?
- 6. 2 Kings chapters 22 & 23 tells of Josiah, king of Judah, "cleaning house." He responds to God's Word by destroying idols in the temple and restoring his commitment to God's ways. What "idols" in your own life need to be cleaned out? Are there any practices God is calling you to begin?
