## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. Who is a man you admire for the way he led, and why? This could be someone you know personally, or a historical or famous figure.
- 2. Read Ephesians 5:21. What comes to mind when you hear the word "submit"? How does this principle shape the way every believer—married or not—should approach relationships?
- 3. Ephesians 5:25 calls husbands to love their wives as Christ loved the church. What does sacrificial love look like in a marriage or family from day to day? How might it look different from the world's expectations of love?
- 4. Ephesians 5:33 calls wives to respect their husbands. Why do you think love and respect are both emphasized in this passage? What is something that makes you feel loved and/or respected as an individual?
- 5. Read Genesis 3:8-9 aloud. God called out to Adam after he and Eve sinned. Why do you think God held Adam accountable first?
- 6. Deuteronomy 6:7 says to repeat God's Word "again and again" to children. What are some creative and consistent ways individuals and families can marinate in God's Word and build rhythms of faith at home?
- 7. How might God be calling you to take responsibility for the next generation through mentoring, fostering, or serving in church?
