Discussion Questions:

1. What is something you have done in your life that felt like a fresh start or “new beginning”?
2. Were you able to attend service in person on Baptism Sunday? Was there a baptism in particular that stood out to you? If so, share which one and why!
3. Acts 8:26-36 tells of Philip meeting an Ethiopian man and sharing the good news of Jesus with him. What does the man’s eagerness to be baptized reveal about the connection between faith and baptism?
4. Read Galatians 3:26-27 aloud. According to these verses, who is baptism for?
5. Read Matthew 3:13–16 and Matthew 28:18–20. How does Jesus’ example and command in these verses shape your view of baptism?
6. Pastor Sean referred to baptism as the starting line, not the finish line. How does this view impact the way you think about following Jesus?
7. Read Acts 22:16 out loud. What are some decisions in our walk with Christ where we often delay obedience? How does this verse challenge that hesitation?
