Discussion Questions:

1. Can you identify a decision you made in the past that served as the beginning of a new chapter in the story of your life? Was it a better chapter or one you'd rather forget? What was the catalyst for that decision?
2. Read Genesis 39:1-10. What stands out to you about how Joseph handled this situation?
3. Think of an area in your life where the decisions you make now could significantly impact your next five years. Would you say you're currently making decisions that reflect the story you will want to tell? Explain.
4. Go around the room and have each person read Genesis 50:20 out loud. It applies to everyone! What word(s) would you use to describe the story you want to tell in five years? Is it a story of someone who has faith? Courage? Generosity? Joy? Something else? Ask God how to write the next chapter of that story today.

More Scriptures to read and discuss if time allows:

- Proverbs 27:12: The prudent see danger and take refuge, but the simple keep going and pay the penalty.
- Genesis 39:21-22: But the Lord was with Joseph in the prison and showed him His faithful love.
