Discussion Questions:

1. What everyday AI technologies do you interact with most frequently? How do they enhance or detract from your life and work?
2. Read 1 Corinthians 1:10. Why do you think unity is such a big deal to God?
3. Read Genesis 11:3-4 & 9. What are some warning signs that technology might be turning into an idol or driven by pride?
4. The sermon described AI as a “neutral tool.” Do you agree or disagree? How does that perspective impact how Christians should use or limit AI?
5. In 1 Corinthians 2:12, Paul notes that there is a difference between God’s Spirit and the world’s spirit. What does this mean with regard to discerning when to use AI and when to pass it up?
6. Read 1 Thessalonians 5:21–22. What does it look like to “test everything and hold on to what is good” when it comes to AI? What are some guardrails you might put in place for your personal use?
