Discussion Questions:

1. When you hear the phrase “Holy Spirit,” what words or images come to mind? Where do you think your perspective came from?
2. As a group read John 14:26 and John 16:7. Have you ever experienced a time when someone advocated for you? What impression has that left in your life? How does it make you feel knowing the Holy Spirit also advocates for you?
3. In Acts chapter 2, the disciples are united in prayer. The Holy Spirit arrives and equips believers with power. The Spirit’s arrival led to boldness, repentance, generosity, joy, and community. Which of these stands out most to you and why?
4. Read John 14:15-17 out loud. Why do you think it matters that the Holy Spirit is a Person, not a feeling or just an experience? How does that change the way you relate to Him in daily life?
5. The Greek word *paraklētos* describes the Spirit as many different roles in believers’ lives. Which of these roles have you seen Him fill in your life? Which role are you most depending on Him to fill now?
