Discussion Questions:

1. When you have to make a decision, what usually leads you first — pressure, preference, people, or prayer? What does that reveal about who (or what) you're really trusting?
2. Read John 16:13. How does the Spirit “guide into all truth” without always giving instant answers? What can Spirit-led guidance look like in real life? If you’re comfortable, share an example of what Spirit-led guidance has looked like in your life.
3. Read John 16:8-11. How is Holy Spirit conviction different from shame or guilt? How can you tell when God is correcting you versus when the enemy is condemning you?
4. Read Galatians 5:16-18. What does “walking by the Spirit” look like in the middle of your normal routines — school, work, relationships, stress?
5. Think about a current or recent “wilderness” season in your life. How might the Spirit be using it to shape you and not just test you?
6. Read Galatians 5:22-23. Which fruit of the Spirit do you see God growing in you right now? Which one feels most underdeveloped and why?
7. What would change in your life if you measured spiritual maturity by obedience instead of emotion? Where might God be asking you to trust Him even when you don’t feel Him?
