Discussion Questions:

1. Have you ever experienced a moment or situation where something worked out so perfectly that you knew it could not be a coincidence? Describe it for your group.
2. What is something you used to feel one way about, but now see completely differently after understanding it better?
3. Looking at six functions of the Holy Spirit during this series (dwells, leads, empowers, transforms, sends), which one do you most closely identify with in your current season of life? Which one is the most challenging or far removed from your own experiences?
4. Read John 3:1-8. What do you think it looks like in everyday life once someone is “born again”? How would you explain being “born of the Spirit” to someone new to faith?
5. Pastor Sean shared several stories of recent life change. They testified to the Holy Spirit drawing people back, healing, restoring, providing, and redirecting lives. Which story resonated with you the most and why?
6. There is a stark contrast between “works of the flesh” and the “fruit of the Spirit.” Read Galatians 5:16–26 aloud. Which fruit do you see most evident in your life right now? Which fruit do you desire the Spirit to grow in you?
7. Pastor Sean asked, “Are you letting the Spirit lead in every area of your life?” What is one specific thing in your life that is particularly difficult for you to surrender? How can our group pray for you or support you as you surrender it to God?
