Discussion Questions:

- 1. What is one moment from this year that you're especially grateful for? What growth or fruit came of it?
- 2. What is something good in your life that you have felt tired or tempted to give up on recently? Read Galatians 6:7-10. What "harvest" will be possible if you don't give up?
- 3. Read John 4:35-38. What do you think it looks like today to "wake up and look around" spiritually?
- 4. This year, many people in our church family took bold steps. These bold steps include confessing sin, getting sober, leading their homes, serving, and reading God's Word. What bold move has God been stirring in you? What help or accountability do you need to take it?
- 5. Read a valuable reminder from Paul in Ephesians 3:20-21. When was the last time you saw God do "infinitely more" than you thought possible?
- 6. Pastor Sean said, "One of the greatest acts of faith and worship is giving." How does being generous financially stretch or grow your faith and honor God?
- 7.
