Discussion Questions:

1. Pastor Sean listed a few examples of the world's view of money and resources vs what the Bible says. Tell the group your favorite way to be generous with the resources/abilities God has blessed you. (This is for generosity inspiration, don't feel like you're bragging!)
2. What are some hesitations that we have when it comes to being generous? How do we grow spiritually to overcome some of those hesitations? Have you grown in the area of generosity since this time last year? If so, how?
3. Pastor Sean mentioned our purpose as a church is to invite everyone in Acadiana to Know God, Find Community, and Make a Difference. Has your life been transformed spiritually by God's work through a local church? Reflect on how you have been impacted and how the generosity of others has made a difference in your life.
4. In 2 Corinthians 8:12, Paul writes, "Whatever you give is acceptable if you give it eagerly. And give according to what you have, not what you don't have." This week, will you commit to reflecting on your habits of generosity? Ask God to reveal to you what, if anything, about your habits should be changed.
