Discussion Questions:

1. What is one of the most generous things someone has done for you? How did it impact you?
2. When you hear the word “generosity,” what is the first thing that comes to your mind? Is it money, time, or something else? What do you think makes generosity so powerful for the giver and receiver?
3. Read 2 Corinthians 8:9 aloud. How does Jesus’ example of generosity shape the way you view your own giving?
4. Luke 12:34 says, “Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be.” If someone were to audit your spending and giving habits, where would they conclude your heart to be?
5. In Genesis 22:1-2, God asked Abraham to sacrifice his son Isaac (the same son God had earlier promised would carry on his family line). Abraham trusted God even when the command didn’t make sense. What does this example of surrender say to you about faith and obedience?
6. At the last moment, God stopped Abraham and provided a ram to sacrifice instead of Isaac. When have you seen God provide exactly what was needed at the exact right moment, in your life or someone else’s life?
7. Proverbs 3:9-10 calls us to honor God with our wealth and what we produce first. Why are we called to do this? What does that look like in real life for you right now?
8. Read Malachi 3:10. Why do you think God connects giving with testing? What are some things that make it difficult for many people to take that step of trust?
