Discussion Questions:

1. What is one “comfort” you enjoy so much it would be difficult to give up? (Be honest, it can be a big or small thing!)
2. Why do you think even good things—like relationships or success in a job we love—can become idols in our lives?
3. Pastor Sean stated that comfort from God strengthens us, while comfort as a god weakens us. What are the differences here? How have you seen this play out in your life?
4. Read Matthew 16:24-26. Following Jesus requires us to do uncomfortable things—like loving our enemies, forgiving those who wrong us, stepping out in faith, and leaving our comfort zone. Which of these uncomfortable things feels most challenging to you right now?
5. When was the last time you took a step of faith that required making yourself uncomfortable? What happened as a result?
6. In Luke 22:41-42, we see Jesus choosing the ultimate act of obedience over comfort. Is God calling you to take a step of obedience or faith? Share it with your small group. What is making it difficult to follow through, and how can the group support you through it?
