"Schemes" = methodia (methods, traps)

9 Schemes of the Enemy

- 5. Keep the Church Entertained but Not Empowered
- 6. Silence Their Prayer Life
- 7. Replace Conviction With Comfort
- 8. Take Out the Men
- 9. Confuse the Identity of the Next Generation
