### Four Gospel Assurances

<sup>31</sup>What, then, are we to say about these things? *If God is for us, who is against us?* <sup>32</sup>He did not even spare His own Son but *gave Him up* for us all. How will He not also with Him grant us everything?” Romans 8:31-32 (CSB)

#### Assurance #1 — LOVED

The cross settled forever where God stands.

The God who chose you won't change His mind about you.

<sup>33</sup>Who can bring an *accusation* against God's elect? God is the one who *justifies*. <sup>34</sup>Who is the one who *condemns*? Christ Jesus is the one who *died*, but even more, has been *raised*; He also is at the right hand of God and intercedes for us.” Romans 8:33-34 (CSB)

#### Assurance #2 — ACCEPTED

Christianity is the only faith where the verdict comes before the performance.

God doesn't love a future version of you. He loves you in Christ right now.

The enemy can raise his voice, but he cannot reverse God's verdict.

<sup>35</sup>Who can *separate us from the love of Christ*? Can affliction or distress or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? <sup>36</sup>As it is written: Because of you we are being put to death all day long; we are counted as sheep to be slaughtered. <sup>37</sup>No, *in all these things* we are *more than conquerors* through Him who loved us.” Romans 8:35-37 (CSB)

#### Assurance #3 — CONQUEROR

If God is for you, every enemy is outmatched before the fight begins.

<sup>38</sup>For I am *persuaded* that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, <sup>39</sup>nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing will be able to *separate* us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.” Romans 8:38-39 (CSB)

**Assurance #4 — HELD**

**Your grip may weaken, but His grip never wavers.**

**No condemnation behind me. No separation before me.**
