WHY IS DISCIPLESHIP IMPORTANT?

Jesus said in Matthew 28:19-20: *"¹⁹Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. ²⁰Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."*

WHAT IS A D-GROUP?

A gender-specific closed group of 3 to 5 believers who meet together weekly to grow as disciples of Jesus. Through spiritual disciplines and discipleship relationships, each believer aims to grow in their faith so that they can become disciple making leaders that help others grow in their faith.
