## Sermon Discussion Questions

Believe and Follow: November 1, 2020

- Read Acts 13:38-39. Through Jesus there is forgiveness for your sins! Pastor Sean shared a story about an Indian chief who was both loving and just to help us get a glimpse of what God did for us. Have you allowed Jesus to pay the penalty for your sin?
  - If you have believed in Jesus how have you seen your life transformed?
  - Or, if you haven't made that decision what are some of your hesitations?
- We tend to think that love and justice are two opposite responses, but Christ showed us that it can be both. How can you have that same response to those around you?
- Read Romans 6:4. Have you made the decision to follow Jesus and make a public symbol of your new life by being baptized? If so, what was that bold step of obedience like for you?
  - What are some of the reasons that might hold us back from baptism after believing in Jesus Christ?
  - God calls us to follow Him in all areas of our lives including things that might make us uncomfortable. What hinders us from being obedient?
- What is your next step?
  - Surrender your life to Christ and allow Him to pay the penalty of your sins.
  - Obey Jesus and make the decision to be baptized.
  - Spend more time with God through his word and prayer.
  - Get connected in a small group.
