Interrogative Baptism Questions Foundations – Part 2 October 29, 2023

Discussion Questions:

- 1. There is something special about celebrating with other fans of your favorite team. It's an even better thing to celebrate transformation with your spiritual family. Share what it was like for you to celebrate with those who made the decision to be baptized on Sunday.
- 2. Read Colossians 2:12 and Galatians 2:20. For those who have already taken that step of baptism, how is it an encouragement to you to see people taking that step of obedience and reflect on your decision? How is it a reminder and a challenge to you about dying to yourself?
- 3. Read Acts 8:26-38. The eunuch didn't make excuses or wait for perfect conditions to get baptized. It was the next step of obedience, so he took it. We can oftentimes make excuses for why we have avoided being obedient to what God is calling us to do. What are some examples of those excuses and the root of them?
- 4. Share a decision or step that God is calling you to and your hesitation for taking the leap.

Some potential next steps:

- Surrender your life to Christ and start a personal relationship with Him.
- Obey Jesus and make the decision to be baptized.
- Spend time with God through His Word and prayer.
- Attend First Steps to learn more about your purpose and get connected at The Bayou Church.
- Have a difficult conversation.
- Step out in faith.
- Work through past hurts and take the steps to forgive.
- Be intentional about developing relationships with those who don't know Christ.
