Discussion Questions:

1. For the past six weeks we have been talking about the truth that more than anything else, God wants a personal relationship with us. What has been your greatest takeaway from that series? How did that series set the foundation for Sunday's message about the Gospel?
2. Pastor Sean and Loren Carriere shared their stories with us on Sunday and how it relates to the story of the prodigal son (Luke 15:11-32). Even though they had different paths in life, they both needed the gospel. Whose story did you identify with more? Have your actions in life led you to lean more towards pride or towards hopelessness?
3. Read Romans 3:21-23. Regardless of how good or bad we think we are, we will always fall short of God's standard. Why do you think the enemy wants us to focus on good versus bad instead of those who are repentant versus unrepentant?
4. Read Romans 3:24-28. It is only by placing our faith in Jesus that we're made right. How can we remind ourselves of that truth when we start to focus on our actions and wonder if we're being good enough?
