Discussion Questions:

- 1. Read John 13:34-35 and 1 John 4:11-12. Our purpose in loving others is to show people that we are His disciples, to be a picture of God's love, and ultimately point people to God. Do you normally think about how your love or absence of love for others can have an eternal impact?
- 2. Read John 15:12. To truly agape the way Jesus did, it's only possible through God's strength. Are you continuously tapping into His supernatural source in order to agape people? If so, how? If not, what are some habits you can implement daily to help you begin?
- 3. Who do you need to agape? Who are the people around you that you need to make a choice to love in a sacrificial and unconditional way every day? Who are the people you've been unkind to, hated, or wronged? Read 1 John 4:7-19. How can remembering who God is and what He has done help us to love those people?
- 4. How do you need to agape those you previously mentioned? Do you need to forgive someone or ask for forgiveness? Do you need to change your attitude toward them by changing your thoughts about them? What specific action do you need to take?
