## Story Relationship – Part 5 October 8, 2023

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. Pastor Sean shared that the main ingredients of every story are relationships. What's your favorite relationship (friends, co-workers, adversaries, romance, etc.) from a book, movie, or television show and what about that relationship is special?
- 2. The Bible is filled with stories of tragedy, love, laughter, and hope. Do you normally view the Bible as a story book (relational) or text book (informational)? Can you recall a time when you were surprised to see a theme or story in the Bible?
- 3. How have you viewed the Bible in the past and present? Has your interaction with the Bible changed over time and if so, how? What's your next step that will help you dig into God's Word for yourself?
- 4. The Bible tells us the overarching story of our relationship with God, which was lost in the beginning but is restored by Jesus. Have someone read Ephesians 2:1-5 aloud and then a different person read Ephesians 2:6-10. Knowing that everyone has a story and that every story matters to God, what do you sense God doing in your story in this upcoming season of your life?
