## The Gospel in Four Chapters: God, Man, Jesus, Faith

<sup>421</sup>... God has shown us a way to be made right with Him ... <sup>22</sup>We are made right with God by placing our faith in Jesus Christ. And this is true for everyone who believes, no matter who we are. <sup>23</sup>For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. <sup>24</sup>Yet God, in His grace, freely makes us right in His sight. He did this through Christ Jesus when He freed us from the penalty for our sins. <sup>25</sup>For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed His life, shedding His blood. ... <sup>27</sup>Can we boast, then, that we have done anything to be accepted by God? No, because our acquittal is not based on obeying the law. It is based on faith. <sup>28</sup>So we are made right with God through faith and not by obeying the law." Romans 3:21-25, 27-28 (NLT)
