Discussion Questions:

1. What is something mysterious or unexplainable you have experienced or encountered? Have you ever had a moment that made you wonder if there was more happening spiritually than physically?
2. Before this message, what came to mind when you heard the words “angels” or “demons”? How did this sermon challenge or reinforce your perspective?
3. Read Colossians 1:15-16. Why do you think it can be difficult to believe in a spiritual reality we cannot physically see? How does this passage shape your view of the unseen world?
4. The Bible does not teach that we become angels in heaven. Read Hebrews 1:14 and Daniel 6:22. What stands out to you about the role of angels in Scripture?
5. Read 1 Peter 5:8. Which of Satan’s “5 Ds” (deceive, distract, divide, discourage, destroy) do you see as a most prevalent struggle? Which one do you personally need to guard against most?
6. Read Ephesians 6:11-18 out loud. How might recognizing the need for this type of armor change the way we respond to fear, temptation, discouragement, or anxiety?
7. Pastor Sean emphasized that believers can confidently fight from victory, not for victory. Read 1 John 4:4. What is one step you can take this week to live out your life from victory instead of trying to reach it?
