#### Discussion Questions:

1. What's something you really wanted (or thought you needed), but once you got it, instead of satisfying your desire it actually left you wanting more?
2. In the Gospel of Luke 12, Jesus warns about the idol of greed and tells the story of the rich man. Read verses 16-19 and share what stands out to you most about the rich man's mindset or decisions.
3. What role does money (or stuff) most often play in your life right now: security, satisfaction, or significance? Why do you think that is?
4. In Sunday's message, Pastor Griff said: greed says "I need more" and worry says "I don't have enough." Which one do you struggle with more, and how does it show up in your life?
5. Jesus says your treasure reveals your heart in Luke 12:34. If someone looked at how you spend your time and money, what would it say you value most?
6. Luke 12:31 says, "But seek His kingdom, and these things will be provided for you." Based on the context of the passage, what is the promise and provision here?
7. In which of these three ways do you need to grow the most this week: practice generosity, pause with gratitude, or pursue trust in God? What's one specific step you can take in that area?
