How can a good God send anyone to hell?

What is the purpose of using hell to scare people into acting right?

Hell is not a tactic from God to manipulate, scare and control people.

"Don't you see how wonderfully kind, tolerant, and patient God is with you? Does this mean nothing to you? Can't you see that His kindness is intended to turn you from your sin?" Romans 2:4 (NLT)

God is not interested in behavior modification. He desires heart transformation.

"And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in you. I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart." Ezekiel 36:26 (NLT)

"This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!" 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NLT)

"³⁶Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the law of Moses?" ³⁷Jesus replied, "'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' ³⁸This is the first and greatest commandment." Matthew 22:36-38 (NLT)

Hell is real. It is simply the complete and forever absence of God.

"7 ... He will come with his mighty angels, ⁸in flaming fire, bringing judgment on those who don't know God and on those who refuse to obey the Good News of our Lord Jesus. ⁹They will be punished with eternal destruction, forever separated from the Lord and from His glorious power." 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9 (NLT)

Hell is something that God does not desire for anyone.

"Do you think that I like to see wicked people die? says the Sovereign Lord. Of course not! I want them to turn from their wicked ways and live." Ezekiel 18:23 (NLT)

God doesn't send anyone to hell. We chose it ourselves.

"God is a righteous judge ... " Psalm 7:11 (NIV)

God won't force anyone who doesn't want to be with Him in this life to be with Him forever in the next.

How does a life of sin warrant an eternity in hell?

"²³For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. ... ²³For the wages of sin is death ... "Romans 3:23, 6:23 (NLT)

God's Word doesn't say: You better be good or you're going to hell! God's Word does say: I love you and I died in your place so you could live!



Good News (The Gospel in 4 Words)

- God
- Man
- Jesus
- Faith

Heaven isn't for good people. Heaven is for forgiven people.

"23For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. ²⁴Yet God, in His grace, freely makes us right in His sight. He did this through Christ Jesus when He freed us from the penalty for our sins. ²⁵For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed His life, shedding His blood. ... ²⁶God did this to demonstrate His righteousness, for He Himself is fair and just, and He makes sinners right in His sight when they believe in Jesus. ²⁷Can we boast, then, that we have done anything to be accepted by God? No, because our acquittal is not based on obeying the law. It is based on faith. ²⁸So we are made right with God through faith and not by obeying the law." Romans 3:23-28 (NLT)

"For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 6:23 (NLT)
