What does God have to say about being single?

God calls some to marriage.

*"⁷But I wish everyone were single, just as I am. Yet each person has a special **gift** from God, of one kind or another. ⁸So I say to those who aren't married and to widows—it's **better** to stay unmarried, just as I am. ⁹But if they can't control themselves, they should go ahead and marry. It's better to marry than to burn with lust. ... ³⁰Those who weep or who rejoice or who buy things should not be **absorbed** by their weeping or their joy or their possessions. ³¹Those who use the things of the world should not become **attached** to them. For this world as we know it will soon pass away. ³²I want you to be free from the concerns of this life. An unmarried man can spend his time doing the Lord's work and thinking how to please Him. ³³But a married man has to think about his earthly responsibilities and how to please his wife. ³⁴His interests are **divided**. In the same way, a woman who is no longer married or has never been married can be **devoted** to the Lord and holy in **body** and in **spirit**. But a married woman has to think about her earthly responsibilities and how to please her husband. ³⁵I am saying this for your benefit, not to place restrictions on you. **I want you to do whatever will help you serve the Lord best, with as few distractions as possible.**" 1 Corinthians 7:7-9, 30-35 (NLT)*

Eternity is way bigger and more important than being married or single.
