Within Relationship - Part 4 October 1, 2023

Week 1 - God is not interested in our empty and obligatory religiosity. He has though invited us into a personal, intimate, and loving relationship with Him.

Week 2 - The path of religion leads to either despair or arrogance. The path of the Gospel leads to humble gratitude and joy.

Week 3 - Jesus invites you to simply walk with Him. It's personal. It's relational. It's intentional. It's intimate.
